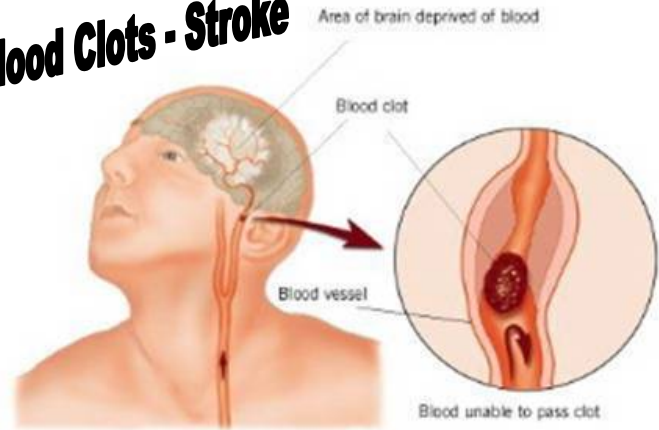

Blood Clots - Stroke



Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

- S** *Ask the individual to **SMILE**.
- T** *Ask the person to **TALK & SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE** (Coherently) (i.e. It is sunny our today.)
- R** *Ask him or her to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.

If he or she has trouble with **ANY ONE** of these tasks, call emergency number **immediately** and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher.

New Sign of a Stroke - - - Stick our Your Tongue

NOTE: Another “sign” of a stroke is this: Ask the personal to “stick” out his tongue. If the tongue is “crooked,” if it goes to one side or the other that is also an indication of a stroke.
